PHILADELPHIA – World-class stride pianist [Neville Dickie](#), on an encore tour from England, will rejoin Tri-State Jazz veterans the [Midiri Brothers](#) for their sixth straight trio appearance. This TSJS event will be an exciting trad jazz, stride and swing program at Haddonfield United Methodist Church, 29 Warwick Road, Haddonfield, NJ on Sunday, May 20th, at 2:00 p.m. A native of England's County Durham, Dickie is among the most accomplished stride and boogie-woogie pianists on either side of the Atlantic. A regular performer on BBC Radio, he's produced scores of records, made hundreds of appearances as a soloist or with his trio and is one of the few British jazz players to score with a hit single. The combination of Dickie on piano, Joe Midiri on clarinet and saxophones and Paul Midiri on drums, makes for a dynamic and entertaining concert.

Half-price admission of \$10, payable at the door, is available for first-time attendees and members; general admission is \$20; full-time students with IDs and children are free. There are no advance sales or reservations. The church is about 15 minutes from central Philadelphia via the Ben Franklin Bridge and parking is free. PATCO is nearby.
