PHILADELPHIA – Combining vintage pop, western swing, traditional jazz and even tango in the programs they put together, Brooklyn and Manhattan-based string band [The Buck and a Quarter Quartet](#) perform at Community Arts Center, 414 Plush Mill Road, Wallingford, PA, on Sunday, October 13th, at 2:00 p.m.

Tri-State Jazz Society is proud to present the quartet who play the forgotten gems of the golden age of American pop, as well as favorites and vintage-inspired

originals in their own category-defying style, described as “skiffle (an early, folk-derived style of rock-and-roll which was a seminal influence on the Beatles and other British Invasion bands) meets Cole Porter.” The result is a mix of material and instrumentation that sounds familiar and classic, yet new and fresh. Since the band’s founding in 2014, gigs have included Pete’s Candy Store, Rockwood Music Hall, Joe’s Pub, Superfine, Jalopy Theatre, The Montauk Club, Freddy’s Bar, The Knickerbocker Hotel and more, plus monthly residencies at KGB Bar’s Red Room and SISTERS Brooklyn for the last four years.

Member admission is \$10, general admission is \$20. **Introductory offer** - start a **new, first-time** TSJS annual membership (\$20) at the door and receive **free** admission to this concert (this offer is not applicable to renewing or reactivating membership.) Full-time students with ID and children accompanied by a paying adult are free. There are no advance sales or reservations. Dancing is welcome at all performances.
